

South Lake Family Trail

1

Start from this signpost by the Wakeboarding centre.

Facing the sign, turn right and head around the south lake in an anti-clockwise direction, always keeping the lake on your left.

Stop at the 'Improvement Works at Willen Lake' sign. What is being built and when will it open?

Visit the bird feeding area. What should you feed to the birds?

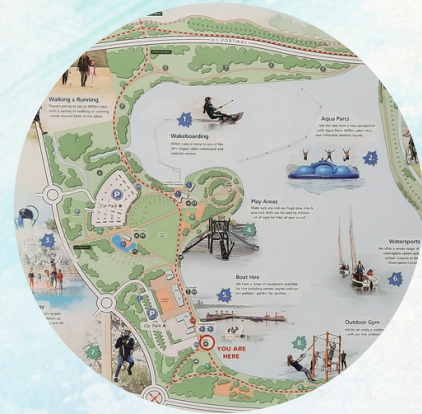


4

Count the yellow bollards between the hotel and the gym. How many are there?

5

Keep going until you reach a green information board. Have a look at all the things you can do in and around the lake. How many water features are there at Splash and Play?



6

Read the signs along the water's edge. Take care as you go near the water.

Can I go fishing here on 1st June?

7

Look up at Treetop Extreme
How many tyres can you count?



8

Head away from the lake and go under the road bridge to look at the trees. Look at what this area is called to help you with this question
What type of trees are they?



9

Head back on to the lakeside path. Find a tree stump to sit on or stand still. Spend a minute being silent.
What can you hear?

10

Choose a space to create a piece of natural art. You could use sticks and leaves to create a picture.
Take a photo of your creation to share with us.



11

Keep going towards the corner of the lake and find the green post with the white and red stripes.
What number is on it?

12

At the corner junction, turn left so you keep the lake on your left. Follow the path and find place to stop and look back across the lake to where you have come from. Look carefully around you at things that are natural and man made.
How many different colours can you see?



13

Keep going towards the road bridge. Before you get there find a spot to stop and look up at the sky. Think of a word to describe the weather today. Are there any faces, animals or monsters in the shapes of the clouds?



14

Go under the road bridge and turn left over the footbridge. Stop and feel the tall grasses and trees at the water's edge. Take care as you go near the water. What do they feel like?



15

At the fork, follow the stone path round to the left and back under the footbridge. Can you find any alder catkins?

16

Follow the path with the lake on your left and look for this tree. Do you know what type of tree it is?



17

Follow the path along the side of the lake. How many swans can you count?

18

At the fork in the path, turn left and follow the path back around to where you started.
